Honduran physicians in Tegucigalpa and San Pedro Sula are thrilled that equipment including EKG, EEG, ultrasounds, x-ray, and mammography unit, as well as valuable donations were put into service within days of arriving in Honduras in August 2006.



Dr. Priscilla Benner and Dr. Herman Sagastume — both working with MAMA Project in Pennsburg, Pennsylvania — were gratified to see the equipment installed and in service. Dr. Sagastume said, “It was worth the trip to see some equipment unwrapped and immediately brought to the bedside of a child fighting for his life in intensive care.”
